The need

The hours that are available during the regular academic day are not adequate to prepare our youth for the rigors of the ACT test and the cost of tutorial programs is prohibitive to many of our students. Although the Lansing School District offers their high school students Advanced Placement and IB classes, due to economic hardship many of the students do not take advantage of the testing process at the end of the course that allows them to receive college credit.

Our Goal

To work with mentors in the community to assist with the cost for high school students to prepare for the ACT and take Advanced Placement or IB tests. It is our goal that all students who would like to participate in an ACT Tutorial Program or take an Advanced Placement or IB test will have the ability to do so.

Achievement

Each high school within the Lansing School District will be given \$2500 a year to assist students with ACT, AVP, and IB testing.
